**OPERATION OF TWO BRIDGE SYSTEM (During the School Summer Holiday Period).**

**Supplementary Instruction to commence on Friday 14/04/17**

**1. Background**

During the period of the works on Poole Bridge the leaves have been in the raised position for most of the time and the IALA signals set to proceed with caution for vessels travelling upstream and downstream. This “free flow” has worked well during a period when the number of vessel movements has been relatively low. However this situation will change and from Easter on maritime activity on Back Water Channel will increase significantly.

**2. Concern to be Addressed**

On a busy lift thirty or more vessels could be released into the basin when Twin Sails is lifted and these vessels will travel downstream through Poole Bridge as a continuous stream. If a vessel is trying to travel upstream through Poole Bridge at the same time it is likely that safety will be compromised to an unacceptable level. This situation is only likely to occur during busier periods when the revised procedure will be followed.

**3. Revised Procedure**

The Bridge Operator must operate the Poole Bridge IALA signals from 14/04/17, during periods when one or both leaves are in the raised position, as follows:

- Arrangement to be followed 7 days/ week
- Applicable from 09:30 to 18:30
- When each lift sequence is commenced on Twin Sails the Poole Bridge IALA signals are to be set to “Stop” (3 red lamps) for vessels travelling upstream towards Holes Bay.
- When Twin Sails has been lowered and the vessels travelling downstream have cleared Poole Bridge the Poole Bridge IALA signals will be reset to “Proceed with Caution” in both directions.
- At all other times the Poole Bridge signals will continue to show “Proceed with Caution” in both directions.

**Mariners are reminded that Radar, AIS, CCTV, telephone and VHF channels are recorded.**
